Friday Twilight was another CRACKER night, 10–15 knots and 25 degrees saw 31 boats out to enjoy a great sail. It was awesome to see the whole fleet finish within 16 minutes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, so handicap is working.

Unfortunately, another two boats failed to submit safety declarations and therefore did not receive a result – Please note you may be contacted during the week.

Sunday Ensign Club Champs Heat 3, temperate upwind down and moving everywhere! Forecast was east to south east but come race-time the breeze had done a 180degree swing to north west giving race management a course rethink and finally settled on 19. This gave a leg in almost every wind direction, and may be shortened if the wind faded... line set and Mr Inflatable... thanks Race Team 😊 game on! Start saw Calypso win the pin with Joker and 2Xtreme left side, paid off at Mr Inflatable and saw Calypso, 2Xtreme, Rogue and Garisenda.

Hard on starboard tack, fleet laid pier mark saw really no changes, out to 25 again hard on port tack this time saw Midnight starting to move through the fleet. At 25 it was a run back with all kites flying to yellow pile. Garisenda the big mover and L'etoile overtook Joker for wooden spoon, but as the wind dropped out the fleet closed up together at yellow.

Calypso, Garisenda and Goats kept in slight westerly breeze, clearing out while the rest of us parked. The wind finally came offshore where it was predicted and this saw kites out again down to R1 and then a great beat home in a solid 15 knots. After Midnight flying home but all too late well behind first three yachts with Calypso taking the line honours over Garisenda by only 13 seconds.

Adding insult to injury After Midnight had another park up but this time in the channel on way to berth, a busy hot day had many on lookers LOL 😊.

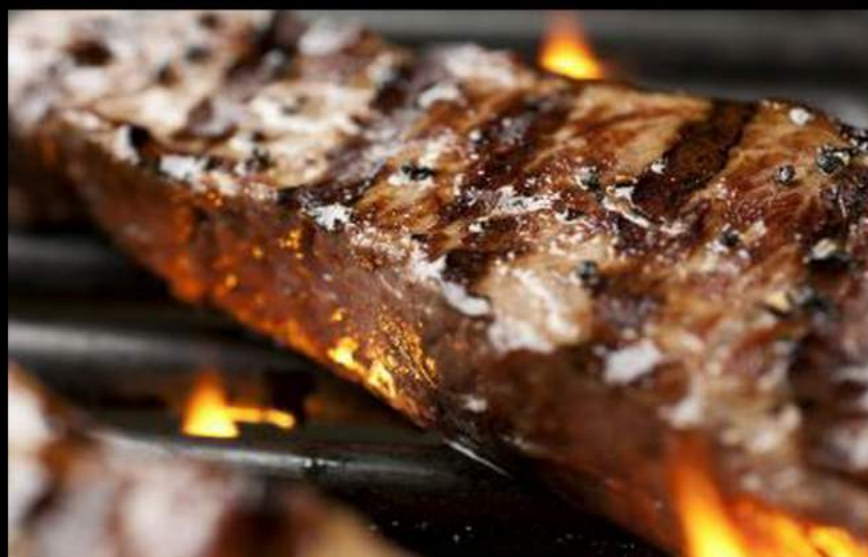
