Chippa's Chirp...



Friday Twilight was a difficult night for the Tower Team and RO, with scattered thunder storms around, nice wind from the east which was well above forecast at steady 10 knots. It was agreed course 2 over course 5 selected to give a nice beat from 25, but unfortunately the wind didn't hang in and died out for a period, then came back in but all too late and the sunset won this race. It was awesome though to see all the fleet within 600m of each other near 25. 😊

Sunday Hidden Harbour Heat 3. Sun was out and so were some new boats which was great to see. Take Two and Smooth Operator so we had nine starters. Just like last week, started West and was moving to the South East, so young RO Nick chose 19. Mono and Sandy on Start 1 were pulling their hair out as set-up was done 3 times as breeze was moving South West to South East then back again. Finally, they had had enough and halved the difference, middle Southerly set-up and with a short line this was going to be interesting.

Two minutes to Start saw less than 5 knots moving to the East and boats cramming for room on starboard tack, needing to keep close to the line to lay the pin, then Balance tried to start on Port tack but couldn't as Joker and Calypso were on Starboard, with a lot of yelling narrowly avoiding contact, (even a national/world champion can get it wrong sometimes!)

Finally we all got away, some better than others. Breeze then filling in from South East, it was Balance and Wild Goats the best at Mr Inflatable, then hard on Port tack the fleet laid Pier mark and then out to 25 saw kites flying but the water was glass out in front of the fleet so the key was to stay in the South East wind lines this kept front runners from getting away and great for us back runners. 😊

At 25 it was Balance, Goats and Calypso the front runners, so hard on the wind back to Yellow gave little opportunity to pass, then passing Green and on to R1 produced a nice kite run. This saw Calypso get their kite twisted like sausages and then they proceeded to drop it into the water and go prawning! (Ha Billy having Beef and Reef for dinner 😊)

This allowed Joker passed having just a little giggle. Around R1 it then became a great beat home in freshening South Easterly 15 knots with Balance and Goats out front - the game was on for third, in the running was Joker, Smooth Operator, Calypso and Rogue, the solid breeze suited the 50 footer best to get over Joker and Calypso.

Rogue had to retire after the forestay broke and was very lucky the rig stayed up - no one was hurt except their pride.

The Grinners on handicap were the smaller yachts this week, well done!!! 😊

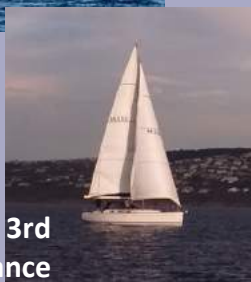

This weeks Juniors update

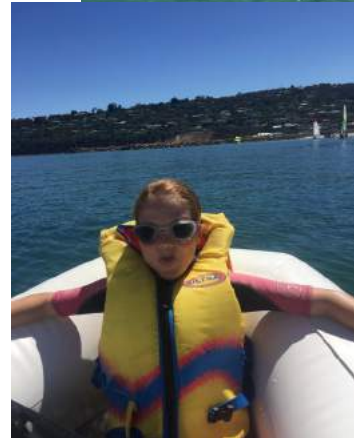
Well done to all juniors who participated in the first week of the trapezoid series, great to see the parents getting more and more involved each week and getting those opti's back on the water!
