Sunday saw 9 boats out to compete in the Commodores Cup with a warm sunny morning but forecast of a strong wind warning maybe scared a few off, but in fact it should have been a NO wind warning!

With the square course set up and line set (thanks to Glen, Geoff, Sandy and team) at about 3 minutes to go the wind dropped out and went about 40 degrees west, Joker saw the advantage and headed to the pin end and tacked onto port and crossed the fleet with the sound of lots of yelling in the background at the boat end (I saw nothink!) once the fleet unravelled themselves it was After Midnight and Joker at the top mark.

But with the wind now at 0 knots most had trouble getting around the top mark and a northerly chop steering backwards was necessary at times, the race crew in seeing this brought no 3 mark in closer to shorten the 3rd leg up , any breeze now went east and After Midnight slipped around mark 2 manufacturing a good lead. Finally, the northerly started, this saw the fleet reaching the next two legs in 5-10 knots of breeze pulling back Midnights lead.

At mark 3 Razors Edge wasn't happy with the shortened course decision proceeded to take it for a ride between its hulls towards McCrae with Joker and Bojangles in hot pursuit. Finally Razor let it go and we all went around it.

The next leg back to mark 2 saw it a nice beat in a gusty 10-20 knots , at the top it was Midnight - Razor - Joker - Bojangles and with a reach back to yellow pile this remained unchanged til the Tower finish.
