Chippa's Chirp...



Friday Twilight with the course set for SW stiff breeze saw the whole fleet home before sundown. La mer, relished the breeze on two reaches and survived the beat to get home in front of Joker on Tourer and it was great to see Emerald on the podium in 3rd.

The weather on Sunday started bloody ordinary with rain squalls and fresh SW breeze of solid 15-18 knots, this saw a few stay in bed I think but those seven boats that came out to play in our first heat of the Hidden Harbour Series were rewarded to a cracker sailing day.

With the new course set up for on water start and short beat, SW predicted to be constant most of the afternoon, a larger course was chosen thanks 2Xtreme duty boat (good choice). With line set favouring start-boat end, this saw the fleet all over Start 1, hope it was not too scary team? You learn for next time... (many thanks to Bill, Dierdre, Sandy, Rob and team).

First short beat to Mr inflatable was a close affair with Wild Goats only one boat length over Joker and then Razor.

Off to R1 saw a good angle to crack out those assys, Razor the quickest and away they shot, Goats second best and Joker and Midnight eventually got them up with Coco not far behind. The next Leg out to 25 saw it a nice beat in 10 – 15knots, with little movement in angles and Razor holding the lead from Midnight and Goats.

At 25 and long run back to R1 forward hands had a good work out, Midnight slow with the kite let Goats pass and Joker went for the big assy and goose winged it and also made up distance. At R1 again saw front three fairly close together.

Back up to 25 was similar, little movement of only 5 to 10 degree shifts made it hard to make up distance, seeing little Rells and Jaslyn now on the downwind to R1, while front runners nearing 25. When rounded Razor took off on a shy reach back to yellow pile, Midnight also sail reaching, Goats went the code 0 and Joker with a small assy but nearly saw us bringing mussels home for dinner just clearing the buoy.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL KEELBOAT SKIPPERS

At the beginning of each racing season all keelboat skippers have the responsibility to submit to the club an up to date YA Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form. **This is a mandatory requirement for all boats racing at SBSC.**

The date for submission of this document has passed and the response has been poor.

Insurance

A second mandatory requirement is the submission of the insurance documents for each boat.

Without a current insurance document the boat cannot race (a YA mandatory requirement).

Make sure your boat is covered for racing.

If both forms are not submitted by OCTOBER 31st, these boats will get a NO RESULT for Friday and Sunday races.
