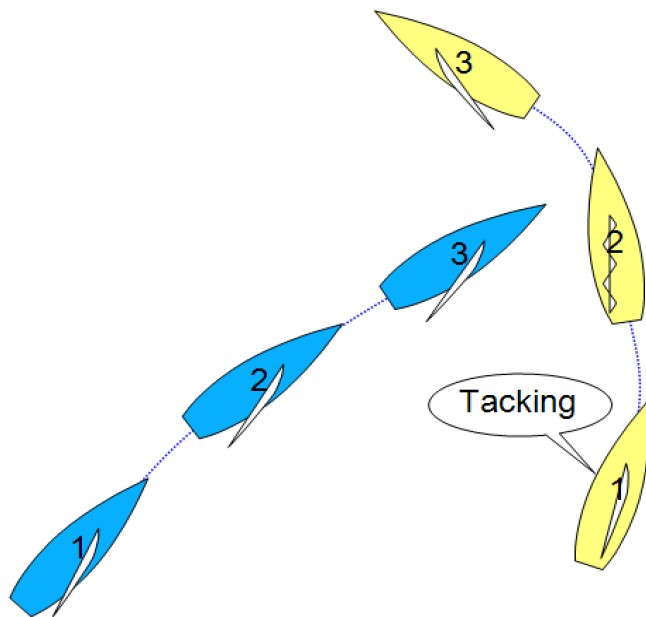

Scenario 02 - Tacking



Q2. Tacking. Yellow hails that she is tacking and immediately begins to tack. Blue immediately alters course to avoid Yellow and passes astern of her.
