## **TOWER PHONE:**

We now have a phone in the tower which is to be used for emergencies or if you have any reason to contact the Tower Officers. This phone will ONLY be operational on race days when the tower is manned.

The number is 0420 393 476.

## **SAILING DAY PASS:**

Just a reminder to all skippers and crew to ensure that non-members participating in any club races are signed up for a Sailing Day Pass. Signing up for the Pass is a great way for non-members to enjoy some races (up to 6) with the club and have personal accident insurance (for the day/s nominated) prior to deciding to join the club.

### **Benefits of the Sailing Pass**

- You have Australian Sailing Personal Accident Insurance for the day
- You can access the club as a member on nominated day/s
- It allows the skippers and crew of racing boats to comply with the “crew eligibility rule 46” in the new blue book
- Provides the club with a record of who is participating in the race and emergency contact details

A person may race up to six races in a year, after which we hope they want to join the club!

The pass can be obtained by the holder through a simple online system on your smartphone, iPad, notebook. You can preselect dates or sign up separately for each day you sail.

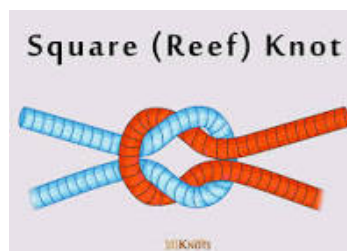
