



SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2018 Waszp Victorian Championship



1. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAG POLE LOCATION

The Regatta Office is located in the training room next to the kiosk, the noticeboard in the passage to the changing rooms and the flagpole is in the yard adjacent to the club house.

2. SIGN ON – SIGN OFF

Boats shall sign-on before each racing session on the sheets provided downstairs in the passage way from the yard to the changing rooms and sign-off within 30 minutes of the last boat coming ashore for a session. [DP]

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 Race Dates

<i>Date</i>	<i>Races</i>	<i>Warning Time</i>
Saturday, 24 th February 2018	3 to 4	14:00 hrs.
Sunday, 25 th February 2018	3 to 4	11:00 hrs.

3.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

3.3 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 16:30hrs.

4. TIME LIMITS

4.1 Times

Race Time limit	30 min	
Target Time	20 min	Finishing Window 10 min

Failure to meet the Target Time will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a)

4.2 Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window may be allocated a score and directed to return to the start area for the next race. This changes RRS 28.1, 28.2, 35, A4, A5 and S12.3.

5. GRAND PRIX FINISH

After the first boat sails the course and finishes, a Yellow flag will be displayed from the Committee Vessel. Boats **not** on a windward leg shall then proceed to the finish line to be scored Grand Prix style.

6. MARKS

6.1 Marks

Start/Finish Pin	Boat with Orange flag or Red buoy.
Marks 1p, 1s, 4p and 4s	Large Yellow marks.
New Marks	Orange buoy.

6.2 Where there is meant to be a Gate and one of the marks is missing the remaining mark is to be rounded to Port.

7. THE COURSES

The courses will be as per Attachment A of this supplement.

8. THE START

The following replaces Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, instruction 9.

8.1 Races will be started using RRS 26.

8.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel at the starboard end and either the course side of the port end starting mark or a staff displaying an orange flag on a race committee vessel.

8.3 A boat that does not start within 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

9. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

The Mussel Farm to the West of the Club marked with a Yellow mark at each corner is an obstruction and competitors are advised to remain well clear of it. The Race Committee will endeavor to remain well clear of it.

10. CHANGES AND ADDITIONS TO STANDARD INSTRUCTIONS

10.1 The time in RRS S4.2 of 60 minutes for flag **AP** when displayed onshore is altered to 20 minutes.

10.2 Add to RRS S13.1 'Boats intending to Protest shall inform the race committee at the finish or at the first opportunity upon retiring.'
