



## Getting an ORCclub Rating Certificate

1. Contact the clubs Registered Measurer with request to have your yacht certified.
2. Jason Close is the Registered Measurer for Safety Beach SC and can be contacted at [jclose@closecommercial.com.au](mailto:jclose@closecommercial.com.au)
3. Supply Jason with AMS or IRC certificates relating to your yacht.
4. Complete the ORCclub rating application on the AS site at [2020 ORC Club applications and forms - Australian Sailing - Resources](#)
5. Most of the measurements required for an ORC club Rating will be on your AMS certificate or can be sourced from the yacht's manufacturer by your Measurer.
6. Some measurements will need to be measured on the yacht in your pen.
7. After receiving your new ORCclub rating certificate pay the invoice attached. \$45 is the current introductory fee.
8. Send copy of your certificate to [keelboat@sbsc.net.au](mailto:keelboat@sbsc.net.au)
9. ORCclub certificates need to be revalidated on an annual basis.

Note: If you do not have an AMS certificate you may need to have your yacht measured up along with sails on a grass area near your yachts location, if this is the case apply for both an AMS and ORCclub Rating Certificates as both systems of handicapping are still being used and trophies awarded at most clubs.
